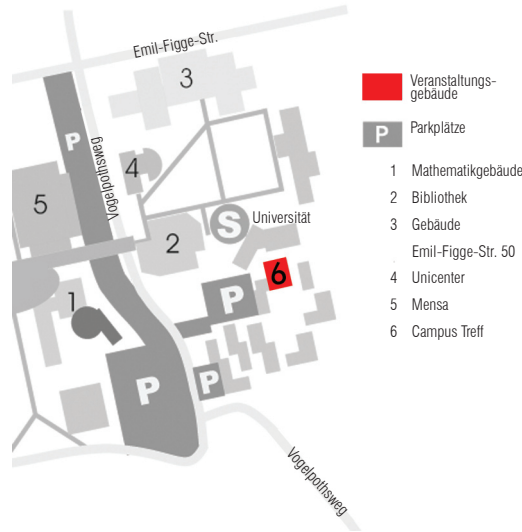

## „Feminist Politics in the 21st Century - Theoretical Concepts - Political Strategies“

Which strategies are appropriate to achieve gender equality in the new millennium? Since feminist approaches and political movements have become more differentiated during the nineties, the women's movement, politicians and renowned feminist scholars are once more dealing with this question. Gender policies, strategies of empowerment and approaches to gender democracy have to be re-evaluated and redesigned according to changing social and structural conditions. Processes of institutionalisation and professionalisation have modernised women's politics and women's studies. However, structural inequalities in employment, legal systems and social institutions still persist.

Feminist theorists such as Judith Lorber and Ilse Lenz call for a new synthesis of concepts that have until now either affirmed or questioned institutionalisation as a response to processes of differentiation. They argue in favour of a new relation between theory and political practice and a continuing resistance against the powers which stabilise old categories. They expect feminists and „others“ to challenge hegemonic structures and practices.

The workshop deals with the following questions:

- What do the recent changes in feminist theory imply for gender politics?
- Who is the (political) subject in current concepts of gender equality?
- In which ways does it make sense to connect feminist scholarship and gender politics (“theory and political practice”)?

The workshop will deal with these questions and related areas of feminist debates which cover a wide range of contributions from different generations.
